

Championships East Intent Form & Instructions for 2018

You should submit the attached form, page two and three, if you would like to be considered for membership on a NY/UC Region team for USPC Championships East. (PLEASE READ CAREFULLY BEFORE COMPLETING)

Step 1: Complete the information at the top of the form (name, address, etc.).

The "Qualifying Rating Level" is your rating for the qualifying competition, not necessarily the rating you will have when Championships take place. Horse's name should match the name on the Coggins.

Step 2: Complete the Choice of Discipline section.

- Please check eligibility requirements for each discipline BEFORE completing this section. They can be found on the
 USPC website under Publications, Forms, Qualifying Criteria for Championships, the Championships Gold Book,
 Rulebooks under "Disciplines", and Discipline Newsletters all found on the USPC website. Eligibility requirements
 can include age, rating, outside competitions, affidavits of qualification, etc.
- Rank your preferences. If you don't want to be considered in a particular discipline, please indicate by marking "N"
- To be considered as a Stable Manager in any discipline, you must have competed in the Qualifying Rally in that Discipline, either as a stable manager or as a rider.
- If you have selected Games as one of your preferences, and your team qualifies, Games is automatically considered your #1 preference.
- Quadrille Division- Must declare intent to compete in this division <u>TBD</u> to determine if there are enough teams for a competition or exhibition only. Qualifying rides are not required. Please list teammates in the chart below.
- If you have selected Pas De Deux vs Musical Freestyle for dressage, please list the name of your partner in the chart below.

Step 3: Complete the "About You and Your Family" section.

- Tell us about experiences you may have had, such as competitions away from home, that indicate you will be a good representative of the Region at Championships. If your discipline requires affidavits or qualifying competitions, please list them.
- In addition to entry fees, transportation to/from championships for you and your mount, housing, and meals, there are additional required expenditures such as Region t-shirt and other uniform as required, Region Patch, attendance at prep clinics, etc. The Region will reimburse a portion of the entry fee following Nationals. Some reimbursement may also be available from your club.
- All NY/UC nationals' competitors may be required to attend one or more clinics and or meetings before Nationals. Absence from prep clinics or meetings may necessitate changes to team assignment.
- Please refer to the NY/UC Policy regarding selection for National Championships: "Selection of National Candidates also take into consideration judges' recommendations, experience, sportsmanship, teamwork, horse management, safety, DC recommendations and other factors as may be appropriate"
- Obtain required signatures prior to submitting form.

Step 4: SUBMIT the completed form directly to the **Regional Supervisor or Designee.** The RS or Designee should have your form in hand by the <u>Closing date</u> of the first Qualifying Rally in which you want to be considered. Please include with your completed NI form: two (2) Coggins if applicable, Volunteer Form, and Chaperone documentation. (Note that each Region is required to furnish a chaperone and two volunteers per team.)
