Although teaching doesn't formally enter certifications until C1, D's can practice by showing one another skills like safety release knots, markings on their own mounts and their favorite grooming tools. TALKING together about HM skills & unmounted knowledge topics is a first step to teaching it. It also reinforces a D's own knowledge when they can show others. The "people skills" that trip up many upper level candidates with teach start way back at the D level. In addition, be sure C and up members get opportunities to PLAN and DELIVER activities at club meetings, rallies, and other PC events. If you don't have younger members to teach, look to the surrounding clubs, to the Regional Youth Board's visiting instructor initiative or even teach one another for the practice. Good teaching skills take time to develop. Start early, practice often!!
